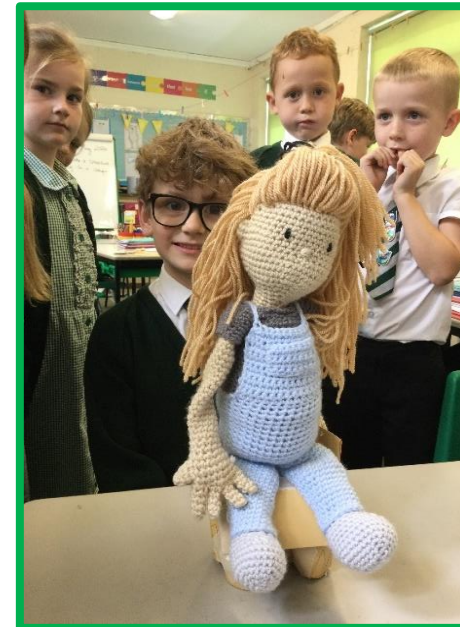


FROM THE HEAD'S CHAIR
