HAZEL CLASS ASSEMBLY

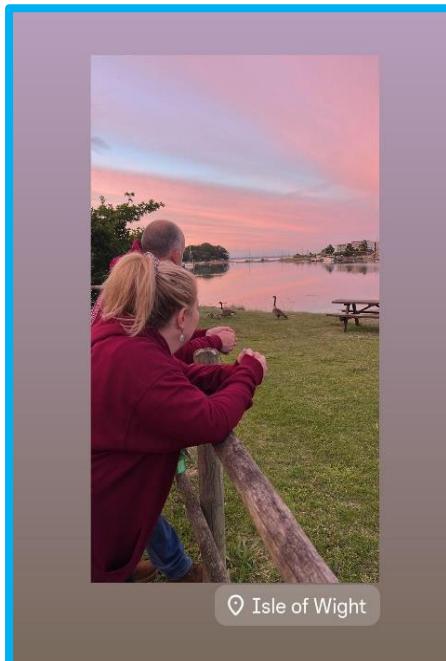
