


#### RAISING MONEY FOR OUR SCHOOL!



Was your child born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021?

If yes, Buckinghamshire parents can apply online for a school place from 5 November 2024, Visit buckinghamshire.gov.uk/schools-and-learning/schools-index/school-admissions to apply.

You must apply even if your child is at the nursery attached to the school you would like them to go to.

Information about starting school for the first time will be available on our website from the end of October buckinghamshire.gov.uk/ischools and-learning /schools-index/ischool-adminssions.

The application deadline is 15 January 2025, please do not miss it
