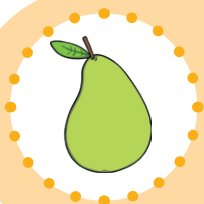

For example: I wanted pasta **but** I had to have rice.

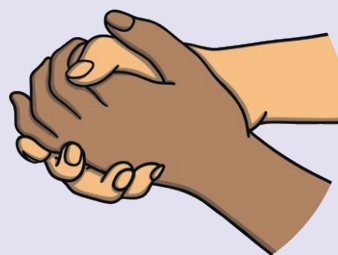

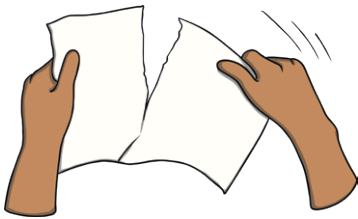

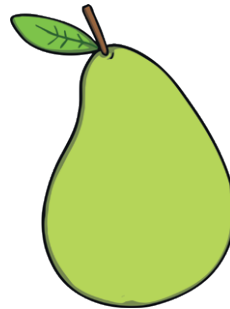
