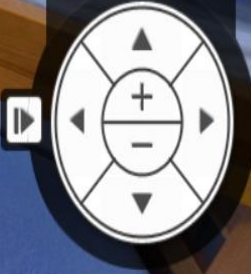

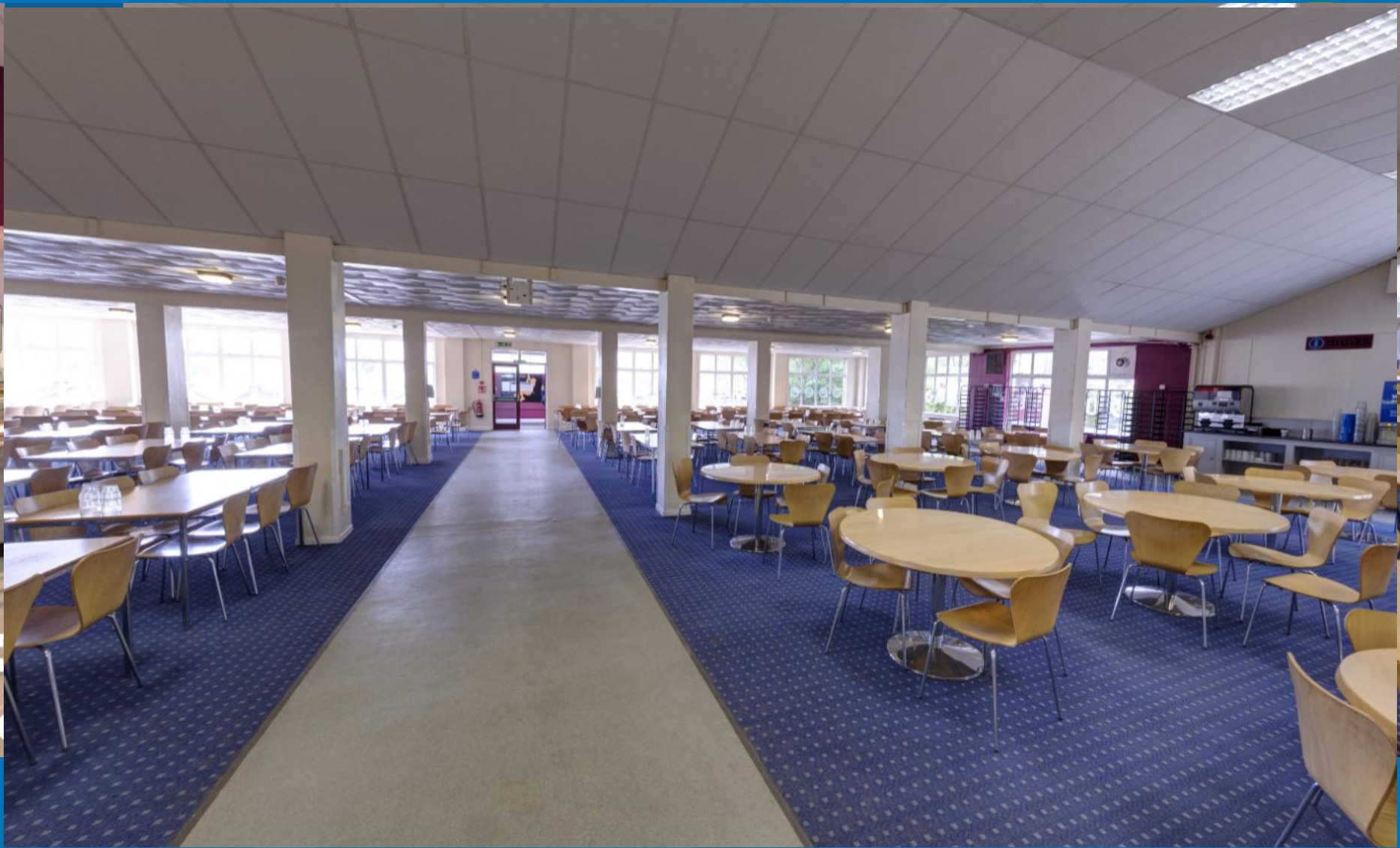


Catering & dietary needs
