Exploring History: Year 6 Studies Shackleton's

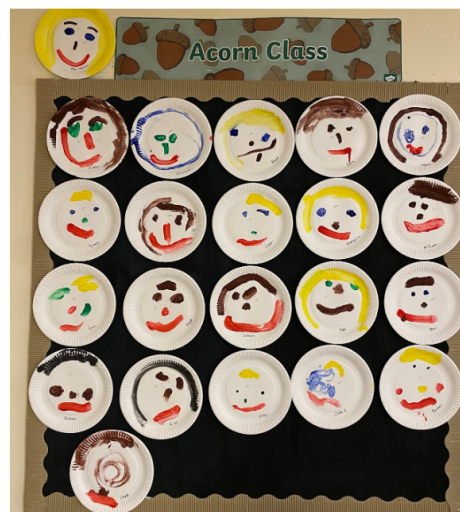


Expedition

Year 6 have been learning about the expedition of Ernest Shackleton to Antarctica, 1914–1916. The children put together a timeline of the events which occurred on the expedition, which culminated with every man returning alive, against great odds. It is an inspirational tale of perseverance, resilience and even optimism, as Shackleton made another attempt at a later date to accomplish the challenge he had set himself. The children of Year 6 are finding this topic extremely interesting.

To kick off our 'Marvellous Me' topic, the children explored their facial features in mirrors, observing the shapes and colors in their reflections. Parking

As we return to a new academic year and the school run, please can I ask all of you to take extra care and consideration as you drive to school in the mornings or afternoons.

1. Please park safely and considerately of other road users and pedestrians — remembering not to block access and driveways.
2. Please do not park on the double yellow lines or yellow zig-zags — they are there for a reason!
3. Take care of your speed as you use George Road and surrounding roads and please try to respect our unofficial one-way system — it helps everyone if we stick to it.
4. Please use our 'Kiss and Drop' if you have children in Year 1 or beyond. This is a safe, supervised way of dropping off and delivering your children in the morning.
5. Please be aware of the added impact of vehicles related to the building work going on at the edge of Britwell Court.

Digital Citizenship

Following up on our recent smartphone policy update, we kindly remind parents to remain vigilant about general online safety and the specific apps children are accessing at home. To support our pupils in navigating the online world safely, we are now delivering our curriculum using Common Sense Media, and we have officially renamed these lessons from 'online safety' to Digital Citizenship. This shift reflects a move towards empowering our students to understand the impact of their digital footprint, helping them become active, responsible, and thoughtful contributors online rather than passive technology users.

Health & Safety Reminders

- **Nut-Free School:** We have students with severe nut allergies. Please ensure packed lunches contain no nuts, including items like pesto, Nutella, and certain cereal bars.
- **Return Student Medication:** Bring any required inhalers, EpiPens, or prescriptions directly to the main office in their original, labelled packaging.
- **Keep us Updated:** Inform us of any new or changing health conditions so we can keep care plans current and support your child effectively.
- **Medical Queries:** Contact the main office for any health-related questions. Staff will route your query to a trained First Aider.
