### **BEBRAS COMPUTING CHALLENGE**



SNUGGLY RECEPTION READING TIME





### **QUESTIONNAIRE RESPONSES**

Thank you to everyone who replied to the parent questionnaire. The feedback was overwhelmingly positive about the school with 92% of you saying that your child feels happy at school and 93% saying they feel safe. 93% of parents feel that their child is well looked after and 86% feel that teaching is of a high standard. Other high scores were for the curriculum we offer, approachability of the school, information in the school newsletter and more. Comments strongly reflected pride in our school,



our sense of community, our passion for looking after the children and the hard work and amazing impact of the staff team on all of our children. There were several areas that we can continue to work on, the majority of which were around the effectiveness and consistency of communications so we will be working hard to improve this in the coming weeks and months.
