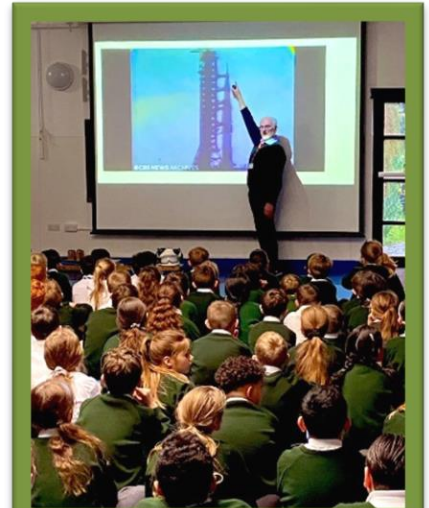
NURSERY STORY SESSIONS

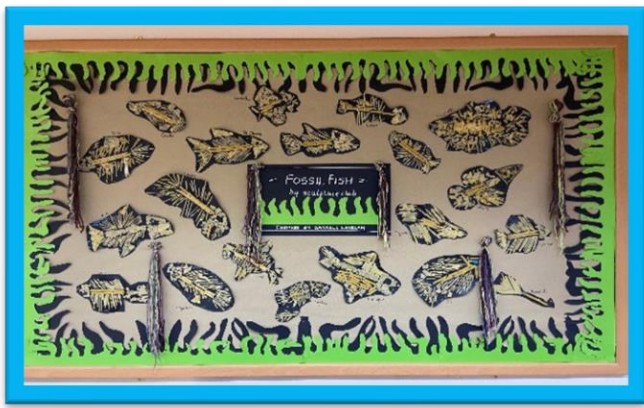
GOLDILOCKS IN THE DOCK!


